Cornelia Wrzus is an assistant professor at the Johannes Gutenberg University Mainz, Germany. Before acquiring a PhD in Psychology at the University of Potsdam in 2008, Cornelia Wrzus was a visiting researcher at the College of William & Mary, Virginia, in 2007, working with John. B. Nezlek. From 2009 to 2013, she was a post-doc at the Max Planck Institute for Human Development, Berlin. Currently she works on short- and long-term processes of personality development, personality-relationship transactions, and “age-fair” personality measurement. Her methodological expertise ranges from experimental and ambulatory assessment paradigms over longitudinal designs to meta-analytical approaches. In 2015, she received the William-Stern award for her innovative research in personality psychology.
