ISISA Student Scholarships

18th 'Islands of the World' Conference – Zadar and surrounding islands, Croatia
June 13-17, 2022





The <u>International Small Islands Studies Association</u> (ISISA) and the organizers of the 18th *Islands of the World* Conference to be held on Zadar and surroundings, Croatia, are pleased to announce a **scholarship competition** to assist students (mainly postgraduate) to meet part of the expenses of attending this conference.

A maximum of **TWELVE** awards, equivalent to €500 each, will be made to suitable student candidates, who will be presented with their awards at the Conference. SIX of the awards are funded by ISISA, the other SIX by the Croatian organiser of the Conference, the University of Zadar.

Applications, by email only, should be sent to the ISISA Secretary, Dr Laurie Brinklow, at brinklow@upei.ca by **5 February 2022**, and must include the following:

- name and current institutional affiliation of the student applicant;
- postal address;
- email address;
- name of degree for which the student applicant is registered and year of registration;
- title of paper to be presented at the Conference;
- abstract of paper as submitted to, and accepted by, the Conference; and
- statement of motivation: a statement, of around 150 words, on why it is important for the student applicant to attend this conference.

To qualify for consideration, students MUST have their abstracts accepted by the *Islands* of the World XVIII Conference; any application from a student whose abstract is not officially accepted will not be considered for an award.

The applications will be considered by a panel consisting of both ISISA office holders and representatives of the Croatian organizers, whose decision will be final. Selection will be based on merit of abstract, its relevance to island studies, as well as by an interest in ensuring a regional and disciplinary diversity of participants.

Note: Scholarship beneficiaries are still required to pay the conference registration fee.
