**OBJECTIVES AND EXPECTED RESULTS**

WASTEREDUCE is the first Interreg Italy-Croatia project focused on improving waste management in protected and Natura 2000 areas by implementing a holistic landscape approach. The project's pilot areas include Sakarun Beach, the Istrian West Coast, and the Middle Brenta River.

The project will help improve existing waste management policies and practices, raise awareness and change the behavior of visitors and other stakeholders, reduce the environmental and socio-economic costs of waste management and associated impacts, and improve cooperation between stakeholders at transboundary, national, regional and local levels in the field of waste management.
