








Most of SUNBEAM partners (17 out of 20) are also members of the UNIADRION network

- ✓ <u>Internationalization</u> → SUNBEAM is seen as an opportunity to improve the institutional level of internationalization
- ✓ <u>Visibility</u> → contribution to increase the visibility of the institutions and a better reputation and image in the area
- ✓ <u>Management of international mobility</u> → partners that have limited experience with organized outgoing and incoming mobility see in the project an opportunity to strengthen their management capacity at institutional level and in the organization of the IRO
- Cooperation between EU and the Western Balkans → most partners consider the collaboration with institutions belonging to the Adriatic-ionian area an excellent opportunity for their own development

Beneficiaries spend a period of time in another participating country gaining valuable experience of life, study and work with the aim of increasing the opportunities available to them in the future.


KA 103 Mobility between Programme Countries


